## THE PREPARATORY DEPARTMENT IN A DISTANCE LEARNING FORMAT FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS



The preparatory department in a distance learning format (remote) for foreign citizens conducts online education and prepares students for the entrance exams and admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year faculties of the First Pavlov State Medical University: General Medicine Faculty, Dentistry and Pediatrics Faculties

Subjects covered on the course include chemistry, biology, physics and mathematics

Distance learning preparatory course continues from November 30 to June 1. Foreign citizens with a complete secondary education as well as students of the graduating classes of a secondary educational school can enter the training. After enrolling on the preparatory department students study subjects with teachers and professors from the university. In groups of 10–12 people they study Russian, chemistry, physics, biology and other subjects. They do homework, attend online lessons, and take oral and written tests. At the end of the academic year, students take final exams in the subjects they have studied in the entrance examinations format for foreign citizens first year. The exam is conducted remotely under of a special proctoring program control that tracks using of Internet resources or other inappropriate behavior during the exam. Entrance exams for foreigners entering Pavlov University remotely are held in the same format. If the applicant has

the right to enter a university as a Russian citizen, exams are held only in person (offline).

In case of successful exams passing, students receive a certificate of completion the distance Pavlov University preparatory department. The final grades in the certificate are given by teachers taking into account academic performance and attendance during training and final exams passing.

At the end of the academic year, an organizational meeting with an online broadcast is held. The rector of Pavlov University, academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences, professor S. F. Bagnenko usually takes part in the meeting. International applicants can connect and attend the meeting during the broadcast in real time, can ask questions in the chat. The recording of the meeting remains on the university's website. Applicants' questions are usually saved and published on the website after the meeting.





## **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS** (Required Documents for the Distance Pre-entrance Program for foreign citizens):

Original or notarized copy of national passport with a notarized Russian translation (send the scan-copy in your Applicant Personal Account);

• Original or notarized copy of School Leaving Certificate (High school diploma) or Certificate of secondary professional education in a medical-biological field (with marks in Chemistry, Biology and Physics) with a notarized Russian translation (send the scan-copy in your Applicant Personal Account);

Application for Admission (printed from your Personal account after On-line Pre-Entrance Program Registration and Admission checking, sign, and send the scan-copy of the Application with signature in your Personal account in the form of an information message);

The training contract, printed from the applicant's personal account after preliminary online registration and verification by the admissions committee, must be signed by the applicant, scanned and attached as an information message.





Online calendar for submitting documents: The acceptance of documents begins on October 1. The acceptance ends on November 30. Tuition fees: 140 000 rubles per academic year.

All documents must be submitted online. Mandatory online registration is required. Create a personal account, fill out the registration form and attach the required documents
